



## MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

As a condition of their membership, all members are required to respect this Code of Conduct. The Member Code of Conduct sets out the behaviour expected of get2gether members:

Report any Member Code of Conduct violations to the Director immediately.

The Director will review the incident and assess the likely future risk to the individuals concerned.

The Director will consider banning individuals from future events and other get2gether activities if appropriate.
